Host an Organisational Raid

Cross-sector solutions to workplace challenges

Raids provide you the opportunity to host one of our members from a different sector. Up to 20 delegates would come for a one-day visit to obtain first-hand understanding of your approach to a shared challenge.

Your organisation gets to showcase expertise and experience whilst exploring cultural differences. You promote the innovative approaches you have used in solving particular issues and offer guidance in how these might be applied within the visiting organisation. Delegates' perspectives can also be a useful way to reflect on your own processes.

Raid objectives & delegates:

Delegates are generally drawn from either across the visiting organisation or from the same team, department or sector of the organisation. They can be from any level of seniority up to Board Level.

WIG will work with the raiding organisation to narrow down their objectives and then match them to the appropriate host. We will then organise a call between the two organisations to work out the agenda and logistics.

Raid Format

We recommend dividing the day into four or five one-hour topics: each **about 15** minutes with a speaker followed by 45 minutes of interactive discussion.

Speakers can network with the delegates over coffee breaks and lunch.

We find it works best to have a room set up boardroom style so that people can easily engage and ask questions.

WIG would help facilitate the day, working in advance with both organisations to ensure that both get the most out of the raid and find it interesting and engaging. Each organisation benefits from a deeper understanding of the other's structures, ways of working and operational constraints.
