Who is it for?

Graduates or equivalent, with between two and ten years of work experience, identified as having high leadership potential.

How it works

Modular – The programme takes place over six months, allowing you to develop within your work schedule.

Experience based – You will be working in a small team of participants from different backgrounds and with different expertise, to deliver an agreed project for a not-for-profit organisation.

On-going support – Your team will be coached throughout the project. You will also benefit from one-to-one coaching, communications training and personal development.

What you will gain:

- Learn how to understand and influence meetings and how to manage group dynamics
- Become a more confident presenter and a more capable networker
- Learn how to assess your impact on others
- Understand what is expected of future leaders
